Hong Kong Sanatorium & Hospital Establishes Voluntary Work Group "Village Volunteers"

First Charitable Event "Walk for Vision" Raises Fund for Ebenezer School & Home for the Visually Impaired

Not only do staff members of HKSH devote themselves to health care profession, but they also devote efforts to community services at leisure time. Over the years, they participated in activities such as Oxfam Trailwalker, The Community Chest Walk for Millions, Run to Beijing Charity Marathon, Sichuan Earthquake Fundraising Campaign, flag days, just to name a few. To play a bigger role in corporate social responsibility, the HKSH Village Club initiated the establishment of Village Volunteers, a voluntary work group in April 2009, to organize community service activities and encourage participation among doctors and staff members of the Hospital.

The inauguration of the Village Volunteers was held on 26 April 2009 (Sunday) at the Starting Ceremony of its first charitable event, "Walk for Vision" walkathon. It is an event supported by Dr. Ellen Li Charitable Foundation, with an aim to raise funds for Ebenezer School & Home for the Visually Impaired. The target amount of donation is HK\$740,000. A custom-equipped 16 seater minibus will be purchased using the fund for the transportation of children with special needs. Surplus will be used on future voluntary service for Ebenezer School & Home for the Visually Impaired.

Over 200 HKSH staff and their families gathered at the Hospital entrance at 8:00am on 26 April. The Hospital is pleased to have Dr. Leong Che-Hung, JP to be guest-of-honor of the event.

The route of the "Walk for Vision" ran from the Hong Kong Sanatorium & Hospital, passed through Wong Nai Chung Gap Road, Violet Hill and finished at the Hospital. All participants completed the 11-kilometre walk within 4 hours.

Looking ahead, the HKSH Village Volunteers will organize and take part in various community service activities in order to help more people in need in the society and fulfill the responsibility as a good corporate citizen.
